### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1.0 Rules

The event will be governed by the New Zealand Maritime Transport Act, Maritime Rules Part 22, Collision Prevention, this Notice of Race and the Rudder Cup Centennial Race Instructions.

#### 2.0 Advertising

Authorised advertising only will be permitted on race day

#### 3.0 Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The event is open to classic power boats owned and/or skippered by financial members of the Classic Yacht Association of New Zealand (CYANZ) and must wear their approved CYANZ launch numbers

3.2 Entry will be accepted for those vessels that the Race Committee consider are in keeping with the spirit of the event.

3.3 The entry fee for the event will be \$30.00 (incl GST)  
Entries will be accepted until 1700hrs on Monday 28 November 2011.

#### 4.0 Schedule of the Event

4.1 All competing vessels must comply with the Safety instructions for the event and may be subject to random inspection.

4.2 The Race is scheduled to start at **1000hrs** on 3 December 2011. The Race will use a Mark Foy start, based on the handicaps allocated by the Race Committee.

4.3 The Race Committee reserve the right to delay the start in the event of inclement weather

#### 5.0 Race Instructions

The Rudder Cup Memorial Race Instructions will be issued to accepted entrants and be available online: [www.classicyacht.org.nz](http://www.classicyacht.org.nz) by 22 November 2011

#### 6.0 Race Area

The course will be in the Waitemata Harbour and Hauraki Gulf.

#### 7.0 Alternative Penalties

7.1 For a boat that is judged to be over the start line at the start and fails to return to start correctly, a scoring penalty of 20% of her elapsed time shall apply

7.2 Decisions of the Race Committee will be final

#### 8.0 Prizes and Trophies

8.1 The CYA Rudder Cup Centennial Trophy will be presented to the winner of the race, being the first boat across the finish line at the CYA Annual Prize giving on Wednesday 23 May 2012

8.2 An unofficial prizegiving will be held on shore at Patio Bay about 7.00pm

#### 9.0 Team Support Boats

No outside assistance is allowed.

#### 10.0 Photographic Rights

In participating in the race each competitor, their crew and guests grants to the Organising Authorities, their sponsors, agents and licensees, the right in perpetuity to take, make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures, live or taped television or other forms of image taking of them during the regatta, to promote or publish the regatta, and not in a manner that suggests a personal endorsement or promotion of any goods or services by any person depicted.
